The Department of Translational Genomics is offering a scholarship opportunity to members of the Keck School of Medicine community to cover registration or workshop fees for the **2025 ACMG Annual Clinical Genetics Meeting**, which will be held March 18th-22nd at the Los Angeles Convention Center.

This opportunity is available to **students** (undergraduate, graduate and medical students), **trainees** (postdocs, residents, fellows), **clinical and research staff** involved in medical genetics (genetic counselors, dietitians, nurses, research associates, etc.), and both **clinical and research faculty** (MDs and PhDs).

All members of the KSoM community are eligible to apply, including (but not limited to):

- Individuals from underrepresented groups in science and medicine
- Members of the LGBTQ+ community
- Individuals with disabilities
- Members and leaders of KSoM Inclusion Resource Groups (IRGs)
- Participants, volunteers and leaders of departmental/school diversity, equity, inclusion & belonging efforts

Up to \$3,500 in registration fees will be provided in total for these scholarships, and we hope to fund as many individuals as possible **to help augment their training in genetics/genomics**.
