NWCs (Req)	If not submitted, reach out to Mandy Garcia about how to submit	Completed
CV	Too late to submit, focus on 10 experiences	Completed

May 31, 2024	2024 ERAS season ends at 5 p.m. ET.
June 5, 2024	2025 ERAS season begins at 9 a.m. ET.
Sept. 4, 2024	Residency applicants may begin submitting MyERAS <sup>®</sup> applications to programs at 9 a.m. ET.
Sept. 25, 2024	Residency programs may begin reviewing MyERAS applications and MSPES in the PDWS at 9 a.m. ET.
May 31, 2025	2025 ERAS season ends at 5 p.m. ET.

- There is no need to write a paragraph-form narrative
- It is recommended that you copy/paste from your Keck CV-formatted CV

#### 2024-25 JGMESB "Military Match" Timeline for Medical Students

Timeframe	Activity
May - October 2024	Complete ADT (Active Duty Training) rotations at military hospitals
1 July 2024	Letter of Instruction (LOI) from each Service posted
1 July 2024	MODS system opens for applications
31 August 2024	Deadline for initiation of applications in MODS
15 October 2024	Deadline for modification of applications and upload of supporting documents in MODS
July-October 2024	Interview Period
18-22 November 2024	JGMESB "Military Match" occurs
11 December 2024	JGMESB "Military Match" results notification

Active Duty Training (ADT) are required rotations at military training hospitals that serve as audition rotations for GME. ADTs also cover Basic Officer Training, ADTs performed at school, etc. The typical HPSP student will perform two clinical rotations at a military training hospital.

## OBGYN ResidencyCAS APPLICATION

### Obstetrics and gynecology residency programs will be using ACOG's specialty-specific residency application, ResidencyCAS, in the 2024-25 residency application cycle.

For the 2024-2025 application cycle, all OBGYN Residency Programs will be participating in ResidencyCAS. OBGYN applicants will use ResidencyCAS to:

- Apply to OBGYN residency programs
- Signal OBGYN programs
- Request documents supporting the application, such as MSPEs, transcripts, LORs/SLOEs, and USMLE / COMLEX scores
- Schedule and participate in virtual interviews with programs

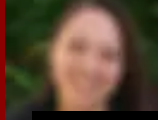

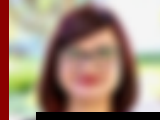

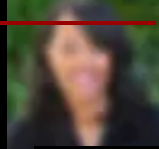
