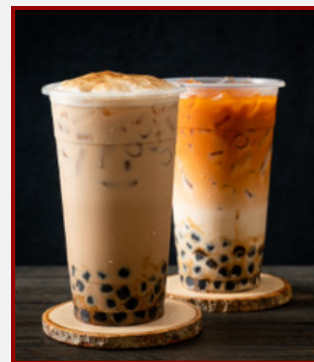
More New Food!

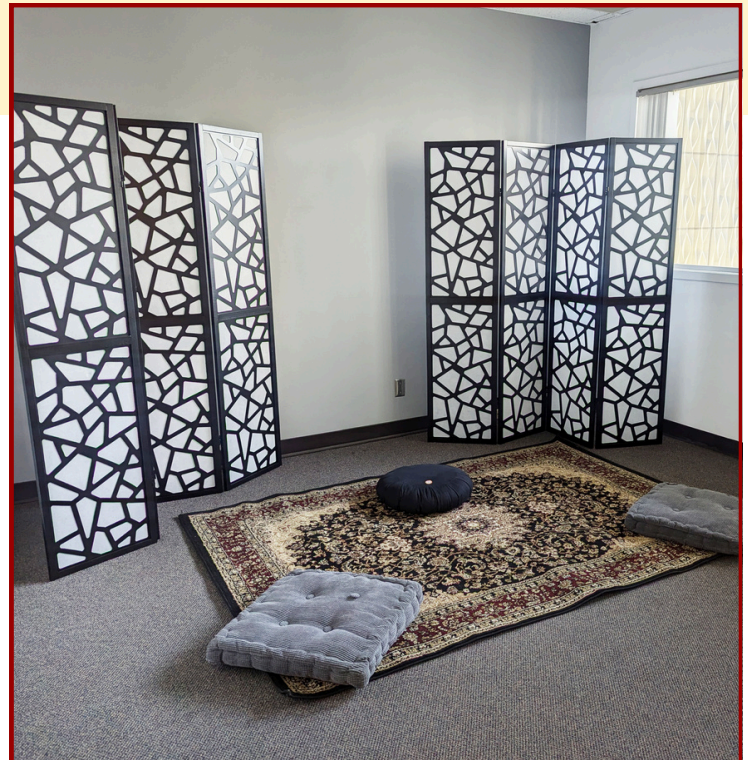

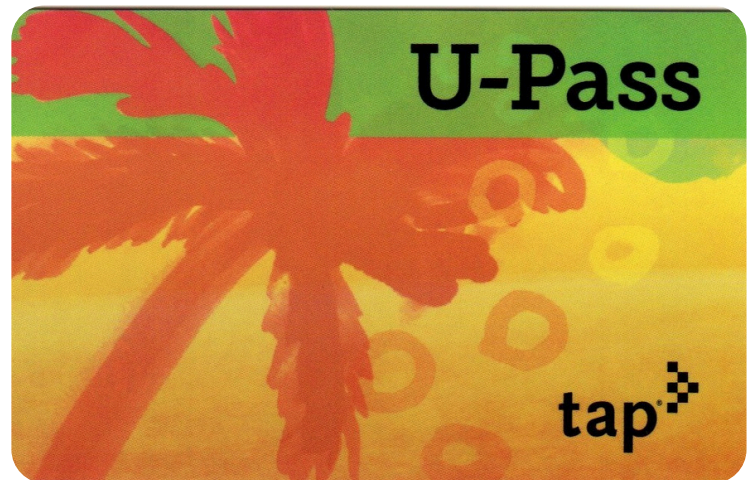
